TERMS AND CONDITION

1. Stall Allotment

The allotment of stall will be made strictly on "First come First served" basis and will be decided by the Organisers.

2. Cancellation

2.1 Failure to make payments as per schedule would render cancellation of stall booking / allocation and no refund will be made. Cancellation of participation is not permitted

2.2 Exhibitors will be deemed to have withdraw if for any reason whatsoever they fail to take possession of the allotted stall / bare space with 24 hours from the date of inauguration of the fair. The organiser may therefore dispose the unoccupied space and the said exhibitors will have no right to claim a refund or compensation even if the space is allotted to other exhibitors.

3. Transport Documents

Participants shall take care to see that the transport documents of exhibits are full and complete to satisfy the statutory requirements to avoid any difficulties enroute. The exhibits should be consigned in the name of the particulars themselves or their local agents and not in the name of the organiser.

4. Entry of Exhibits

- Exhibitors registration and Entry of Exhibits will be permitted only after making 100% payment for all charges including GST.
- Exhibit entry gate will be closed by 06.00 pm on 25th April 2024 and there after no exhibits will be allowed inside.
- Exhibits arriving after 06.00 pm on 25th April 2024 with prior permission of the organisers.

5. Exhibits - Exhibits Out

Authorised representative of the Exhibitor should be present at the time of entry of exhibits at the venue.

5.1 Installation of Exhibits

Shell Scheme can beign installation of exhibits form 24th April 2024 and the same must be completed on 25th April 2024 before 7 pm.

5.2 All exhibitors are advised to start interior work by 24th April 2024 at 10 am and should be completed before 7 pm on 25th April 2024.

6. Closure Fair

On the day of completeion of the fair, heavy vehicle with capacity above one ton will permitted inside only after clearance of smaller vehicles. Mobile crane entry will also be permitted only after the small vehicles move out.

6.1 Fair will close for Visitors at 06.00 pm

6.2 Participants can collect their Clearance Certificates from the Help Desks of their respective halls from 5 pm onwards.

6.3 Hand carriable items will be allowed to move out between 06.00 to 09.00 pm

6.4 Vehicles will be allowed inside the ground from 07.00 pm onwards.

6.5 All exhibits and materials to be cleared before 12 pm on 28.4.2024. penalty will be levied on late clearance.

7. Security

The Organisers will provide round the clock security for the general surveillance of the Trade Fair Grounds, during the event.

On completion of the event, exhibitors are advised to take care of their items.

Organisers shall not be responsible for security of items during stall vacation by exhibitors.

8. Seminar Hall

Halls are available at extra charges providing a unique opportunity to sel your product and services. Technology Promoters can have their video, audio presentation and technical talk. Halls are booked on "First Come-First Served" with prior confirmation of the organisers.

9. Fair Directly

The organisers will release the exhibition Directory giving the following information.

- Name and address of various Exhibitors
- List of product exhibited
- Layout plan showing position of various stalls

10. Insurance

All the participants are advised to arrange for comprehensive insurance for their exhibits at their own cost.

11. Sales

Sale of any product in the fair premise will be subject to the Rules & Regulation of the Government of Karnataka the Govt. of India as the case may be,

11.1 For an Exhibitor who is carrying on business outside Karnataka.

Must get registered as a "Casual Taxable Person" with the proper Officer of the GST Department under whose jurisdiction the trade fair venue falls.

Must submit a Return in the prescribed form after the closure of the trade fair and pay the necessary tax if any sale was effected during the fair.

11.2 For an exhibitor who is already a 'Registered Person' with the GST Department

- ➔ Must get registered as a 'additional place of business' with the jurisdictional proper Tax officer.
- ➔ Must incorporate all the transactions during the Trade Fair in their monthly Returns.

12. Exhibitor Entry Passes

Each exhibitor shall receive two free exhibitor entry passes for stalls upto 18 sq.mtrs. One additional free pass shall be issued for each additional 10 sq.mtrs. Additional passes can be obtained at extra cost.

Vehicle Passes will be issued for parking the vehicles in the parking area.

There are strict parking restrictions around the venue.

13. Advertising in Fair Venue

13.1 Printed matter and advertising material may be displayed / distributed only in their own stall and not in the hall gangways or outside the exhibition halls.

13.2 Moving, acoustic advertising and music are prohibited. The organisers shall be entitled to intervene and discontinue or remove the equipment in case of disturbance.

14. Photographs and films

Organisers have exclusive right to take photographs and films of the exhibition stands. Prior permission of the Organisers will be essential for taking photographs and films by Exhibitors for areas other than their own stands.

15. Force majeure

Under the conditions of Force Majeure which also include strike, bandh, natural calamities and other events and decision beyond the control of the organisers, the organisers are entitled to alter the dates, duration or cancellation of the entire fair. In the event of cancellation of the fair, the participation charges will be refunded after deduction of the costs already incurred by the organisers.

16. Limit of Liability

The organisers are not liable in any form for any loss or damage to Exhibitors property at the exhibition site or injury to their personnel and visitors.

17. Handling Facilities

On site Materials handling will be done by either the organizer or by the authorized agency appointed for this purpose. Participant are not permitted to use other private material handling equipment & machineries.

The Services of Cranes and Forklifts through authorised contractors will be available at extra cost if required

The participant must mention in the application form the details of weight of the exhibits to be handled. This cost has to be settled directly to the Contractor.

18. General

18.1. Participants shall use the space only for exhibition purpose & not for cooking, staying or washing

18.2 The decision of the Organisers of GMEC 2024 will be final and binding with regard to enforcement of these rules & regulations as laid down by the organisers.

18.3 The organisers reserve the right to alter the floor plan, terms and conditions, Allot / Reject the stall Application, even after payment of all dues by exhibitors, without assigning any reason.

18.4 Product Demonstrations if any should be held with sufficient safety measures. Demonstration should be so arranged that Metal Burrs, Concrete, Wood and other scrap emanating out of demonstration should not fly and pose hazard to anyone. Exhibitor should conduct demonstration inside transparent enclosure and ensure that the waste be collected within the allocated stall space only. The exhibitor will be solely responsible for collection and cleaning of waste collected from the demonstration.

18.5 **All display items should be positioned within the allocated stall space only. Any violation from this will not be entertained and the organizers reserve the right to close the stall**

18.6 Exhibits must be positioned / displayed / demonstrated in such a way that it should not encroach into the pathway/ public space (or) cause inconvenience to visitors/ others.

➔ If exhibits are found placed in the pathway the organiser reserve the right to raise an invoice to a tune of twice the area occupied by the exhibits as penalty.

18.7 Any exhibit or process, which generates noxious or toxic fumes or smoke of any kind is strictly prohibited. Also no fuel or inflammable material is allowed in the exhibition premises. The concerned exhibitors are solely responsible for any untoward incident.

19. In Addition to the above points, due to the existing situation, Government may impose additional restrictions or norms which will be applied during the fair.

20. Jurisdiction - All disputes are subject to Coimbatore jurisdiction.
